Single-use Carrier Bag Reporting 2024/25

Wickes Group Plc takes responsibility for our impact and our influence, and we are committed to protecting the environment. Our Responsible Business Strategy 'Built to Last' sets out our approach.

Under the Single Use Carrier Bags Charge regulations, the England and Scotland Devolved Governments' increased the charge for single use carrier bags from 5p to 10p in 2021. The aim of the increase is to further reduce the use of plastic bags and the litter associated with them and to encourage people to reuse bags and businesses to look for alternative solutions. We have chosen to also charge 10p for single use carrier bags in Wales.

We have donated the £2,106 raised from the carrier bag charge to The Brain Tumour Charity, the employee-chosen charity that Wickes supported from April 2023-April 2025. .
